# February Luncheon features Janey Westin, stone letter carver and sculptor

Today Janey Westin is a stone letter carver and sculptor, but she began her career as a calligrapher, a path that was inspired by the art she experienced when she was a Rotary Exchange student to Japan in 1975–76.

After receiving her B.A. in Japanese language from the U of M in 1980, she embarked on an extensive career as a calligrapher, learning the many paper-related skills. In 1984 she turned to stone letter carving, and in 1997 she began

marble sculpting.



Her work can be seen at the University's Donhowe Building and Wilson Library, at the St. Thomas Law School in Minneapolis and St. Thomas University in St. Paul, St. Mark's Episcopal Cathedral (altar and column inscriptions), at the Basilica of St. Mary, the Mary Garden, among others. Her sculptures include a life-size "St. Maria Goretti" at Our Lady of Guadalupe Cathedral and a 14-foot highly incised gilded Lion at St. Olaf College in Northfield.

In 2001 she and her father, Robert

G. Johnson, adjunct professor of geophysics at the University of Minnesota, examined the Kensington Runestone in Alexandria, and in 2012 they published *The Last Kings of Norse America: Runestone Keys to a Lost Empire.* Over the past 30 years she has taught and lectured on these topics as well as medieval manuscripts and rune carving. Janey is married; she has three children and two grandchildren and lives in Edina.
