

Final update on 2015—2016 gifts to the Scholarship Fund

There is absolutely nothing ho-hum about the success of this past year's UMWC fundraising efforts to support scholarships for deserving women students at the University.

The bottom line is: 229 gifts totaling \$56,536. Where did all the money come from? A goodly share came from generous UMWC members—with a number of four-figure gifts as well as a donation of \$10,000 given by a member, who, for the third year, has provided this generous amount anonymously. But the success of the fundraising appeal does not alone account for this total.

This year is extraordinary—we lost a dear friend and one of the club's most faithful, long-serving members. Perhaps few knew just how dedicated Flossie Caldwell was to the scholarships we provide University women students until we were asked to honor her request for all her memorials to be directed to this fund, and until we learned of the ways in which she planned for her personal bequests.

From gifts for Flossie Caldwell's Memorial Service: \$2,380. From Flossie Caldwell's insurance policy: \$9,985. From Flossie Caldwell's will: \$10,000.

Flossie's legacy will surely live in the hearts of us all and in the lives of the students who will be able to fulfill their academic goals because of her scholarship gifts.

Scholarship Committee names recipients of UMWC's 2016—17 scholarships

Forty-seven University of Minnesota women students were selected to each receive a \$2,500 UMWC scholarship this year. The donations from Elwood and Florence Caldwell this year will fund 18 of these scholarships. In addition, an anonymous donation of \$10,000 by one UMWC member will fund four scholarships.

Scholarship money for 2016–2017 (from both donations and bequests) totals a record \$117,500, the increase due to these special donations.
