Director of the Walker Art Center to speak at April conversation luncheon

Olga Viso, executive director of the Walker Art Center, will lead our "Conversation" Luncheon on Tuesday, April 4, with her talk on "The New Walker Art



Campus Inside and Out."

Ms. Viso is known for her scholarship in contemporary Latin American art and the work of the late performance-based artist Ana Mendieta. Before coming to the Walker in 2008, Viso worked for 12 years at the Hirshhorn Museum in Washington, D. C., first as a curator of contemporary art and later as the museum's director. Previous to that she was a curator at the Norton Museum of Art in West Palm Beach, Florida, and held several curatorial and administrative positions at the High Museum of Art in Atlanta, Georgia. In 2013 President Barack Obama appointed her to serve on the National Council on the Arts.

Bring a friend who loves the arts and introduce her to our club's members and great programs.


